**REQUEST FOR FINAL HEARING ON MOTIONS TO OBTAIN CREDIT
ALLOWABLE AS SUPER-PRIORITY ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE
(DE 43 AND 63)**

DB ISLAMORADA, LLC (“Debtor”), by and through its counsel, files this Request for Final Hearing on Motions to Obtain Credit Allowable as Super-Priority Administrative Expense (DE 43 and 63), and in support state as follows:

1. On February 28, 2008, Debtor filed an *Emergency Motion to Obtain Credit Allowable as Superpriority Administrative Expense Under 11 U.S.C. § 364(c) Secured by Superpriority Lien Under 11 U.S.C. § 364(d) to Pay to Reinstate Permits* (DE 43, “Permit Expense Motion”).
2. After notice and hearing on the Permit Expense Motion, on March 6, 2008, the Court entered an *Interim Order Granting Emergency Motion to Obtain Credit Allowable as Superpriority Administrative Expense Under 11 U.S.C. § 364(c) to Pay to Reinstate Permits* (DE49, “Permit Expense Interim Order”).
3. On May 28, 2008, Debtor filed an *Motion to Obtain Credit Allowable as Superpriority Administrative Expense Under 11 U.S.C. § 364(c) Secured by Superpriority Lien Under 11 U.S.C. § 364(d), and Request for Expedited Hearing* (DE 63, “Budget Expense Motion”).

4. After notice and hearing, on June 18, 2008, the Court entered an *Interim Order Granting Motion to Obtain Credit Allowable as Superpriority Administrative Expense Under 11 U.S.C. § 364(c) Secured by Superpriority Lien Under 11 U.S.C. § 364(d), and Request for Expedited Hearing* (DE 75, "Budget Expense Interim Order").

5. Undersigned counsel is aware that the Permit Expense Motion and Budget Expense Motions are approved by the Court only on an interim basis, and it is appropriate to schedule a hearing for consideration and entry of a final order on these matters.

WHEREFORE, Alliance respectfully requests that the Court set a hearing for final consideration of the Permit Expense Motion (DE 43) and the Budget Expense Motion (DE63), and grant such further relief as is just and appropriate.
